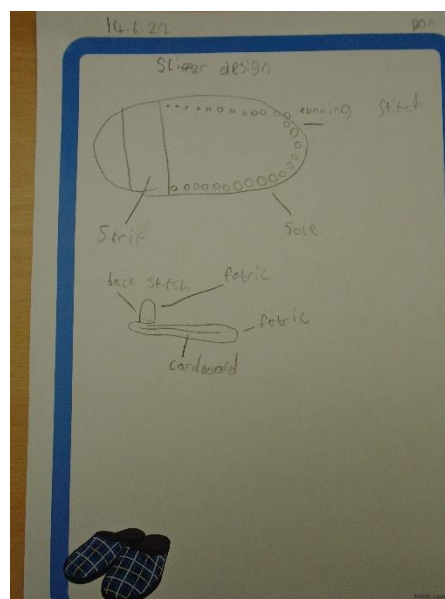

Slippers

The children were set the task to make a pair of slippers for themselves that had to fit and last for an afternoon.



They were shown a pair of slippers and asked to make a simple design. They had a refresher on how to sew and shown three stitches they could use.




Once they were happy with their design, they drew around their feet on cardboard and cut them out, then picked their material and started sewing. They wrote instructions to leave for the Year 5's for next year.

How to make slippers

What you need:

- Needle
- Thread
- Cardboard
- Scissors
- Pen
- Fabric



How to make them:


1. Draw an outline of your shoe on the cardboard.
2. Place the cardboard shoe on the fabric and draw around it for both feet twice.
3. Cut the fabric out.
4. Place the bottom fabric on the table and put the cardboard on top, then place the other piece of the fabric on top. Then sew the fabrics together With the cardboard in the middle.
5. Repeat number 4 for the other slipper.
6. Now you have your slippers but, you still need the strap.
7. Get a piece of fabric roughly 20cm long and place it on the soel. And put the ends of the fabric on the bottom off the slipper and sew the strap to the bottom fabric.
8. Repeat number 7 for the other slipper.
9. Your done.

Top Tip-Sew the fabrics together slowly and carefully to get it right.
