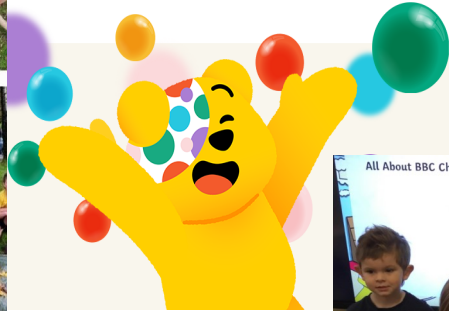

All Saints' Day in Church – children in Year 2 and Year 6 were each given a bible.



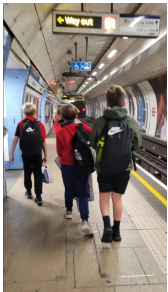
Reception, Year 1 and Year 4 Remembrance activities and our annual poppy display at the memorial in Cockermouth

Year 6 had a day out in London. Taking in a few sights including Buckingham Palace and lunch in St James' Park. The class were very popular with the local wildlife!

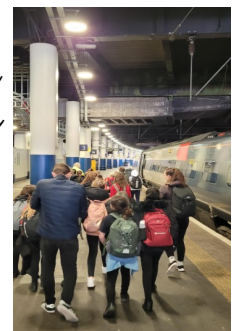

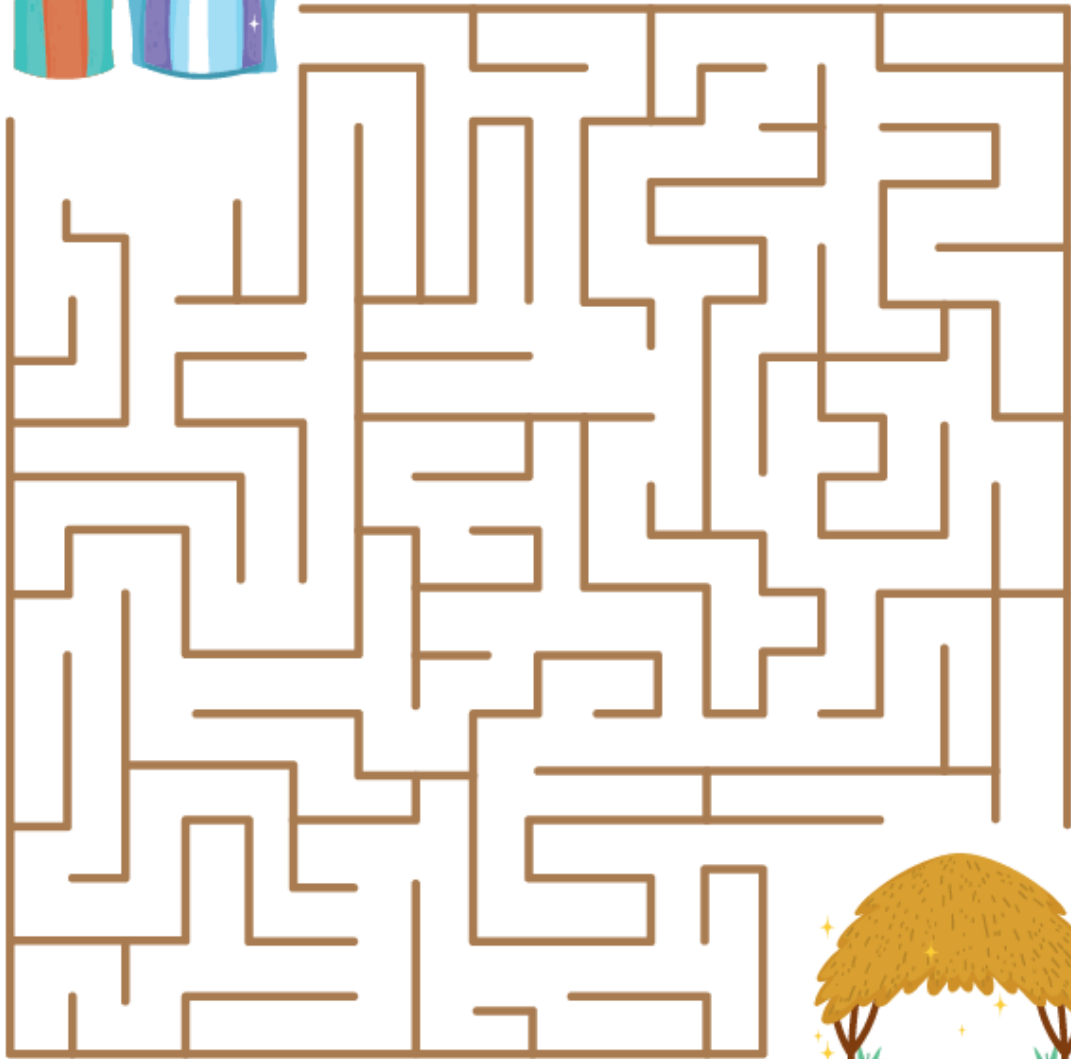

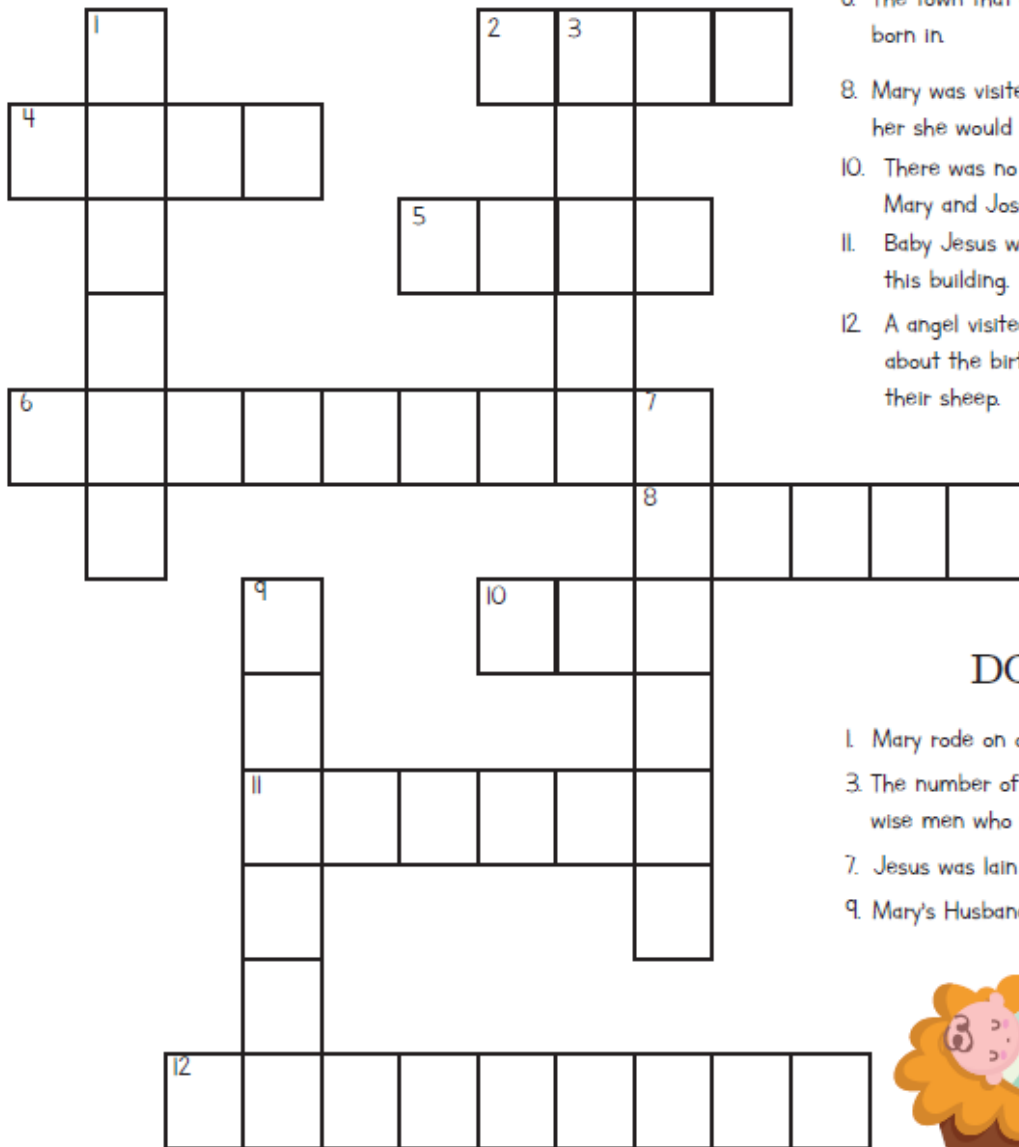

- An angel visited them to tell them about the birth as they watched their sheep.

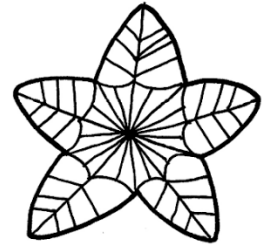


DOWN
