WE ARE AN ECO SCHOOL!

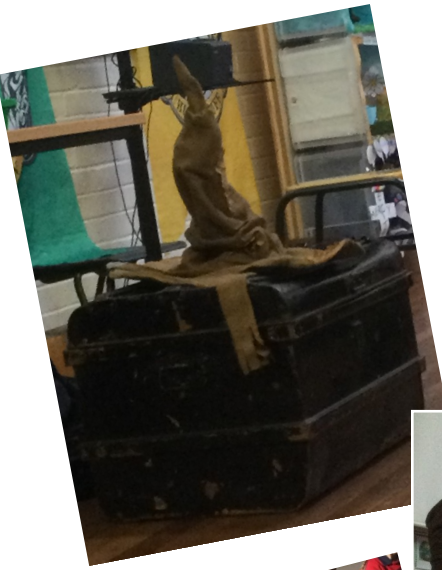


We are very proud that pupils have been awarded a coveted
